Silkscreening is a fun and simple medium that lots of folks think are reserved for large clothing companies. This workshop will end in a warm welcome to the Purple Thistle Centre (a free arts and activism space located just a few blocks away from Britannia).

Workshop provides:

- * Silkscreening non-toxic water based ink
- * Silkscreening frames, squeegies, palettes

- * Scraps of fabric (she will bring lots, and if possible some clothes).

Participants are required to bring:

- * used t-shirts and clothes from home that need some decoration
- * scraps of fabric (cotton blends, polyesters but needs to be smooth surfaced not textured).
