### New and returning crafters and prepared foods vendors:

Deadline for application submission is **Sunday, October 1, 2017 by 4:00pm**. No exceptions. All late entries will be waitlisted and contacted. **No payment required yet**. Accepted vendors will be notified how to register and to pay by Credit, Debit, Cash or Cheque (payable to City of Vancouver). Cost is total \$110 for all three days. \$15 extra fee for those requiring electricity. \$35 Youth table (see page 2)

### JURY INFORMATION:

The same Craft Fair Committee has been reconvened, so only new applications will be juried by appointment this year on Monday, October 16, 2017 (5-8pm). Details and location will be emailed to you. Please bring 4-6 samples that best reflect a good cross-section of your work. Payment is made once you have been accepted. **Craft items must be handmade by you.**

The Britannia Christmas Craft Fair Jury includes representatives from the Britannia Board of Management and Arts and Culture Committee.

## Directions to Jury Room (Conference Room) in the Britannia Information Centre:

You may park in the lot for the Britannia High School/Community Centre off Venables and Cotton Drive. Cotton Drive is one block west of Commercial Drive. There will be signs in the parking lot leading you east and south towards the Britannia Information Centre. There will also be directional signs throughout the Britannia site.

## FAIR INFORMATION:

### Types of Crafts

- **Please mark as many boxes as apply to your work**
- Handmade only – can be produced from a mold that you've made. Please provide picture of mold or bring it if you can.
- Only crafts that are listed on your application and have been juried can be sold. Note: Britannia Community Centre reserves the right to have any unlisted and unjuried items removed from a crafter's table.
- Please do not "fundraise" for a non-profit group at your table, without prior consent from the Britannia Arts and Culture Committee.
- One **youth table** is reserved for 3 artist/artisans under the age of 21 for one day each. Please state your availability and date preference if you are applying under this category.

### Table Space

- 6' x 2.5' tables provided and 2 chairs per table.
- Crafters will provide their own: decorating ideas, extension cords, display props and low wattage lighting (5 – 25 watts only please)

- Gym D in Britannia Community Centre
- Wheelchair accessible
- Close to Commercial Drive Shopping district
- Close to Skytrain and bus route (Commercial and Broadway stations, #21 bus)
