

Artist Trading Cards/ATCs Workshop and ATC Trading Event Come and join us!

Artist trading cards (or ATCs) are miniature works of art about the same size as modern trading cards, baseball cards, or 2 1/2 by 3 1/2 inches (64 mm × 89 mm), small enough to fit inside standard card-collector pockets, sleeves or sheets.

The ATC philosophy addresses the commodification of art and the hierarchies of the art establishment. Among the guidelines for ATCs are these: making them does not require special skills, equipment or materials; ATCs are not critiqued or judged; anyone can make them. ATCs are made specifically for trading.
