Age Range: Children under 10 years old must be accompanied by their guardian during the full time of the workshop. No experience is required.

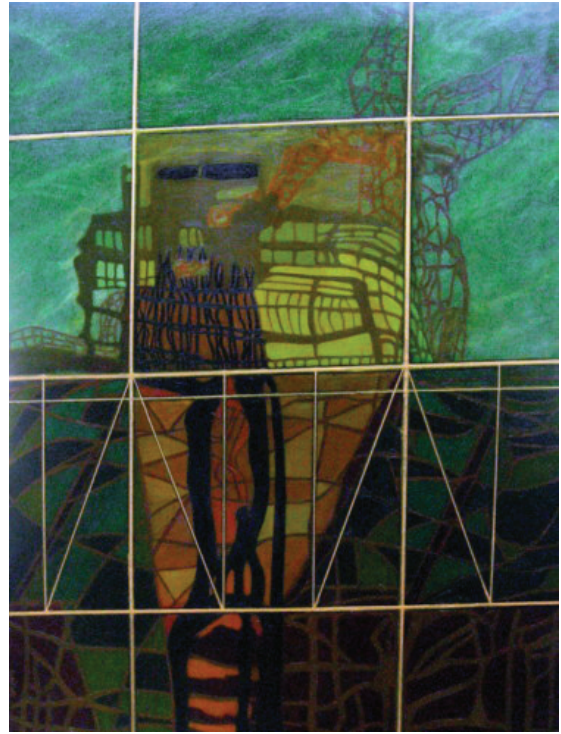

This is a workshop in 5 parts, beginning with a brief introduction and allotment of materials and a short discussion on the principals of art. Participants will listen to 4 different pieces of music. After each piece they will visually interpret their feelings experienced by drawing abstractly, with immediacy onto paper. Upon completion of the 4 pieces the facilitator will introduce the participants to the fundamentals of art through a brief talk and demonstration of techniques. Using their 4 drawings as reference material, participants will combine the different ideas into a single large drawing that utilizes fundamental techniques to create an abstract composition.
