A community where 'we' matter

The Britannia Community Education Centre is located just off Commercial Drive, west of the Napier Greenway, and features many activities and programs for all ages. This summer we are offering five consecutive weeks of 'technology based' summer camps for children between 7 and 13 years of age. Electronics, robotics, video and other hands on experiences interspersed with some quality recreation time should make this experience memorable.



The history behind the Britannia Community Education Centre is a story of neighbourhood action in response to a government proposal to build a freeway through the current property. Dedicated and committed groups and individuals convinced the City to create a true community center on the Britannia site, that would serve every member of the neighbourhood and they did just that. The Vancouver School, Parks and Library Boards all cooperated, (and still do) creating something very special and unique. Their continuing cooperation and grassroots response to this community's needs have made this 18 acre complex an exciting, vibrant and progressive community complex.
