Issue: Proposed 2018 Priority Actions

- 1. Britannia Renewal
 - Work closely with Urban Arts Architecture, City consultants, and any other future consultants to ensure community engagement and dialogue.
 - Maintain a relationship with site partners to ensure effective and authentic co-planning of the site.
 - Understand and participate in City Capital Planning process.
 - Review and research existing operating agreements as well as other similar operating agreement models, to determine potential options for revisions and updates.
 - Support the Planning and Development Committee to establish Britannia principles and guidelines.
- 2. Develop and implement a community engagement and outreach plan.
 - Using the Resilience project and site renewal as a framework for site partners, community engagement and building broader networks.
 - Review and revise communication audit and develop plan that includes two way dialogues with community including community and outreach to various groups to address gaps and challenges in communications.
 - Review and revitalize purpose and actions of Grandview Woodland Area Service Teams.
 - Develop framework that responds to Accountability Pledge.
 - Complete Leisure Access Program assessment.
- 3. Increase access to programs and remove barriers to access (i.e., LAP, subsidy, etc.)
 - Attain subsidy levels of 15%
 - Increase LAP enrollment among qualified residents to 80%
 - Develop sustainability plan to fund subsidy
- 4. Continue building and expanding synergies between different partner groups, where possible maximize use of space for programming.
 - Identify and implement 3 new projects with site partners, involve residents and local groups.
 - Develop internal communications plan with partners.
 - Implement integrated calendar.

- 5. Continue to develop and implement a Reconciliation sharing plan (i.e. Brad's workshop) for staff and community.
 - Organize 6 community events, with, for and by community and residents.
 - Implement inquiry with staff as to staff goals and aspirations for Reconciliation
 - Reconciliation as standing item on team and committee meetings
- 6. Complete Business Systems Review and develop implementation plan to address recommendations emerging from the Review
 - Complete recommendations from Business Systems Review
 - Assess impacts and outcomes
 - Quarterly reporting

Additional follow up to be addressed by Board Development Committee

- 1. It would be beneficial if the Board and Committees would be more familiar with;
 - The history of Britannia;
 - The integrated service model at Britannia and our relationship with our partners, and;
 - The culture of local decision making and the involvement of local residents at Britannia.
- 2. Facilitate further discussions about broadening funding partners in programs.
