Dear Child Care Hub Families including, Britannia, Eagles in the Sky, Grandview Terrace and Mount Pleasant,

As a follow up to our last parent letter on Wednesday, March 25th, we would like to update you on the current progress of childcare services at Britannia Child Care Hub and resources within your community.

Grandview Terrace Child Care is providing care for essential service workers for children ages 6 to 12 years. Due to shortages in staffing, these spaces are limited and may be filled at this time. They are keeping a waitlist for families in need of care.
