We are a successful non for profit licensed daycare. We provide full time care for children aged 2.5 - 5 years.

This Part time Cook position must show the ability to:

- Deliver and provide nutritious daily lunches as well as afternoon snacks in accordance with the Canada Food Guide to 18 months – 5 year old children.
- Ensure the kitchen is maintained in an acceptable standard in accordance with environmental health standards.
- Ability to evaluate the monthly menu and make adjustments as needed.
- Ability to prepare a food order based on the menu needs.
- Ability to purchase food and kitchen supplies.
- Ability to receive food orders and store food in accordance to food safety standards.
- Ability to prep and cook meals and snacks appropriate to the children in care.
- Ability to set up each tables with all needed so that on floor staff can independently serve children at each table.
- Ability to maintain a neat and tidy kitchen both during and immediately after preparation.
- Ability to store leftover food in accordance with food safety standards.
- Works supportively and cooperatively as an effective team member.

Education and knowledge:

- Food Safe Certification
- Current First Aid Certification
- Written verification of physical and mental good health as stated by a qualified physician
- Clear criminal record check
- Six months of recent related experience cooking for children aged 18 months to five years.
- ECE or ECEA certificate is an advantage as more hours are available for casual work in the Day Care or Out of School care programs.

Starting salary: \$16.15/hr plus benefits after a successful probationary period in accordance with the BCGEU collective agreement.
