Deadline for Applications: September 15, 2012.

- 1. 3-5 jpeg images relevant to the proposal. Can be sketches or images of previous work. Jpegs are preferred but printed copy also accepted.
- 2. Your contact info

Your proposal must include the following:

- 3. Statement (no more than 200 words) directly related to the work to be presented at the FEAST.
- 4. How will you use the FEAST funding if awarded? Note: FEAST funding can be used towards anything that enhances your creative experience; this would include rent, transportation, supplies, etc.

Requirements:

- Applicants must work or live in the City of Vancouver.
- Work submitted for the FEAST must be wearable (on the human body) and made of natural materials, i.e. plant-based (an armature or support system of man-made material is allowed but should be no more than 10% of the finished work.)
- Completed application must be received by the FEAST Committee by the posted deadline.

- A maximum of THREE proposals will be shortlisted
- Shortlisted Artists MUST be present at the FEAST on Oct 11th.
- Each shortlisted Artist at the FEAST will be given exhibition space prior to the event that will be displayed during and after the FEAST event.
 Hanging details to be arranged with the event coordinator.
- Each shortlisted Artist will be required to give a 5-7 minute (max.) presentation. If extra time is needed to set up please arrange to do this before the presentations.
- All members of the FEAST audience will be given one ballot to vote for the applicant of their choice at the end of the presentations. Artists do not vote.
- Funding will be up to a maximum of \$750 for the Artist receiving the most votes; \$250 for the Artist with the second highest votes; \$150 for the Artist with the third highest votes.
- In the event of a tie the award amounts will be tallied and split evenly between the artists holding the equal number of votes.
